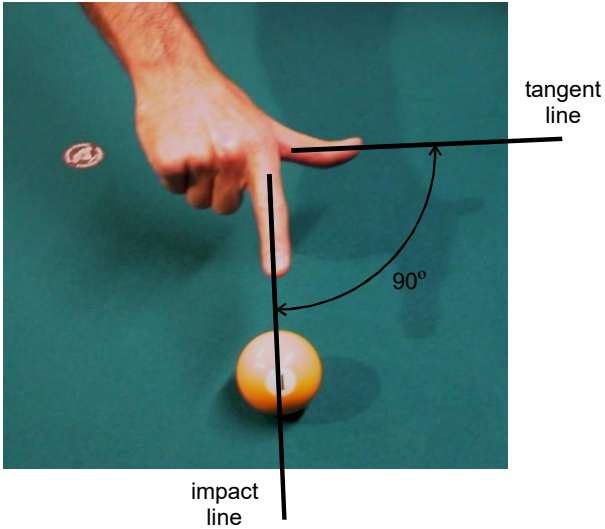
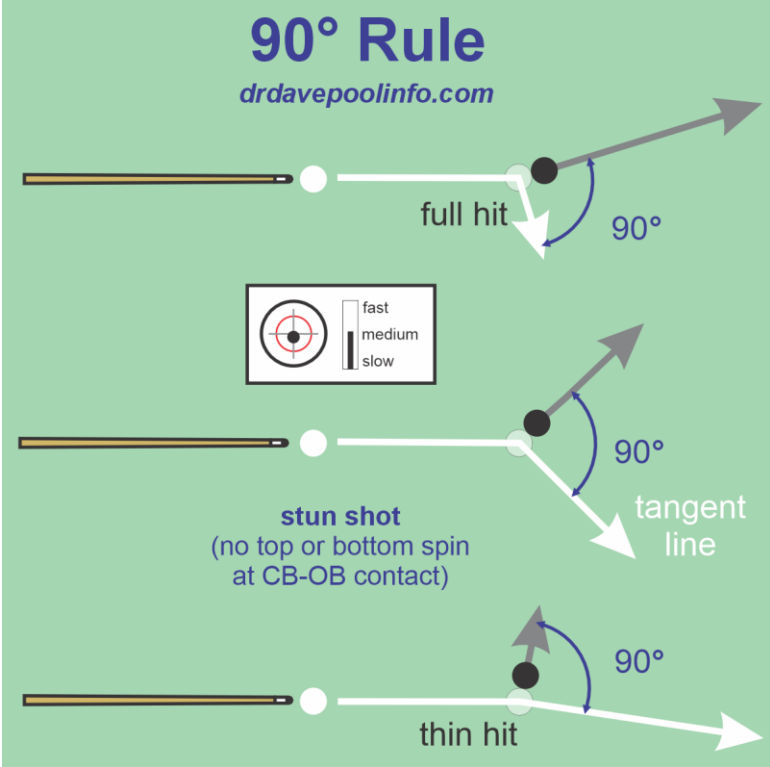


# The 90° Rule

**For a stun shot, where the CB is sliding with no top or bottom spin when it hits the OB, the CB and OB will separate at 90° (the paths will be perpendicular).**

*When the ball has stun,  
this is something you should not shun:  
Point your finger, and the cue ball will follow the thumb.  
If you do this, nobody will think you are dumb.*
